

**Domino Necklace**



**Supplies**



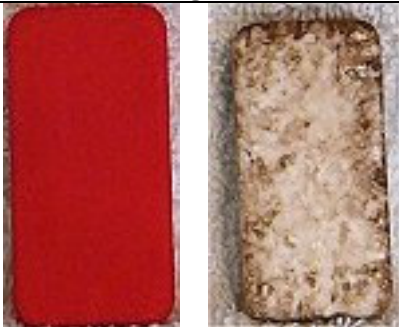
Wax Paper for surface protection  
 Plastic Dominos found in the games area of most toy departments  
 Plastic tube bead found in the beading area of the crafts department  
 Sanding Sponge found at most hardware stores  
 Clorox Bleach  
 Natural Sea Sponge  
 Rubbing Alcohol & Cotton Balls

Various art brushes for painting the design  
 Acrylic paints in colors of your choice  
 Acrylic Varnish  
 E-6000 glue  
 low tack painters tape  
 scissors  
 1/8" silk ribbon or cording that will fit through the hole in your bead

**Preparation:**

- ✚ Soak dominos in bleach and water (1/4:1) overnight. Rinse well and dry.
- ✚ Apply a layer of Multi-Purpose Sealer to the top and sides. allow to dry well

**Background**



**Background:**

- ✚ Paint the domino with acrylic paint in the color of your choice or use a dampened and blotted sea sponge to tap on color allowing some of the domino to show through. Allow to dry.
- ✚ Apply a layer of sealer over the background color, let dry. Sponge a second color over the background color, if desired. Dry, then apply one more layer of multi-purpose sealer...allow to dry.

**Sealer**



✚ If you want your necklace to be the natural domino on the back...Remove any paint that has crept to the back of your domino with a cotton ball and rubbing alcohol. Be careful and not allow the alcohol to run down the sides.

**OR**

- ✚ Seal and paint the back of your domino and allow drying.
- ✚ Trace and transfer your pattern onto the domino or free hand your design.

## Painting:

- ✚ Paint the design, in colors that coordinate with the background.
- ✚ Follow the directions of your pattern packet if applicable.
- ✚ Allow to dry.

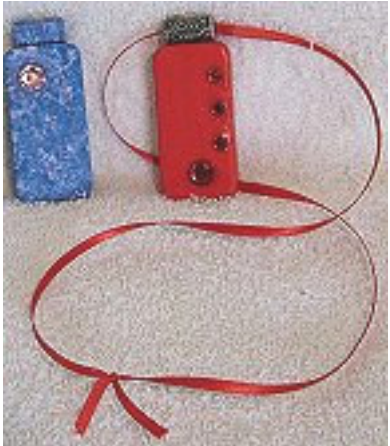


## Finishing:

- ✚ Use a small amount of the E-6000 glue to attach the bead to the top edge of the domino. Make certain that the hole of the bead runs parallel with the top of the domino so it will hang flat once the ribbon has been threaded it through the hole. Use a piece of the low tack tape to hold the bead in place while it dries.
- ✚ You would also glue any rhinestones or other embellishments to the domino at this time. Allow several hours for drying before varnishing your pendant.

- ✚ Varnish your domino and allow to dry well. You may use any good quality acrylic varnish on your necklace pendant. Apply several layers of varnish with a soft brush allowing each layer to dry well before applying the next.

### Ribbon



- ✚ Thread the ribbon, cording or chain through the hole of the bead and tie in a square knot. To measure the ribbon...wrap the ribbon around your head then add about 6 inches for a short length
- ✚ Have fun experimenting with your Domino Necklaces. Consider adding more embellishments such as Rub-on designs, ribbons, lace and almost anything. As long as you can glue it in place, it's fair game.
